Draw a large oval for the body and a smaller oval, half inside the larger one.

Step 4:



Draw some rounded fins.



Draw a small squashed oval, this

will be Little Hector's nose!

Give Little Hector his eye and eyebrow. At this stage you can erase the lines you don't need.



## Step 7:

You've drawn Little Hector! Now maybe draw him a nice ocean background to swim around in. Step 3:



NOTE: If you draw steps 1-4 lightly you can erase them later.

Draw a triangle for his tail.

Step 6:



Draw lines to show Little Hector's unique markings.
